Our mission is to do research and use the latest scientific and technological achievements **to educate highly qualified engineers and scientists.**



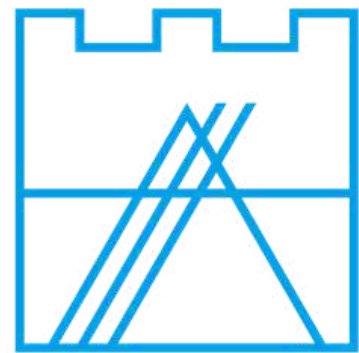


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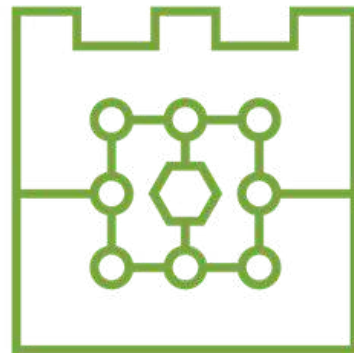
Educational offer



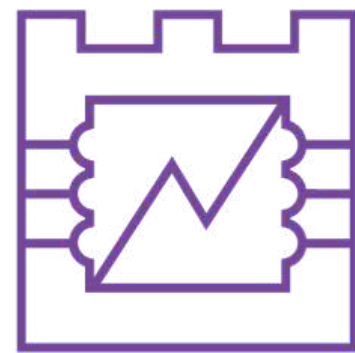
Cracow University of Technology offers variety of study majors and courses.

at **8 faculties**. All faculties offer English-taught courses available for exchange students.



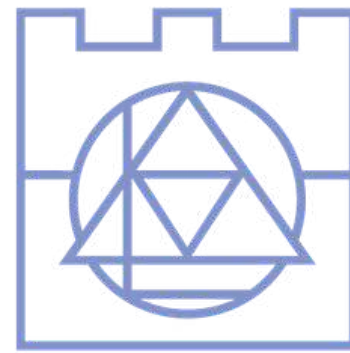

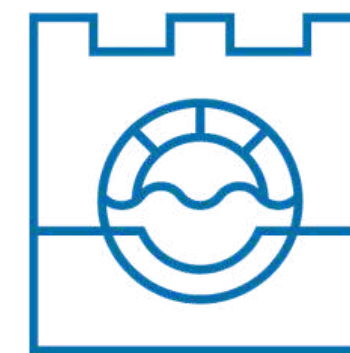

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To apply for the exchange program students should:

- be officially nominated by their home institution through PK KUT's online form
- have successfully completed at least 1 year of study at their home institution by the time of nomination
- meet the English language requirements

Required documents for the application:

- application form (signed by student)
- copy of passport or national ID
- transcript of records (in English)
- English language certificate (not applicable to English native speakers)
- passport-type color photo on white background

Deadlines

FALL SEMESTER

- Nominations: 16th April 2027
- Applications: 14th May 2027
- Semester dates: 1st October - mid-February

SPRING SEMESTER

- Nominations: 16th October 2026
- Applications: 13th November 2026
- Semester dates: 1st March - end of June

Transcript of records release

Fall Semester - beginning of March; Spring Semester - by mid-July.
Transcripts are uploaded to the CUT platform, and students are notified via email.
Hard copies can be provided to the student's home institution upon request.
