Course description:	The course comprises lectures and laboratory exercises. It aims to provide the student with an understanding of programmable logic controllers (PLC) and the acquisition of the ability to design automation systems.
	 Introduction to programmable logic controllers and programming language using Siemens controllers. Basic and advanced elements of ladder programming language. Ladder diagram and other utils for PLC programming like function block diagrams, structured text, instructions lists and sequential control language in a TIA Portal programming environment. Human-machine interface (HMI) and PLC cooperations in a network. Control and monitoring operator panels design and implementations. Functions and Functions Blocks, Data Blocks, Organisations Blocks. Structured and unstructured applications building. Sequential functions charts. Different methods of function chart implementation. Examples of industrial control applications. Distributed control applications examples using programmable logic controllers and communications issues.
