The examined person and the educational institution are entitled to appeal against this medical certificate. The appeal must be contained in the written form. The appeal and the justification shall be lodged within 14 days from the date of receipt of this medical certificate, through the doctor who issued this medical certificate, to the provincial center of occupational medicine, competent for the seat of the educational institution, and in the case where the appeal relates to the medical certificate issued by the provincial center of occupational medicine - to the research institute in the field of occupational medicine.
