Exchange students will be subject to the registration after applying for the Foreign Registration Card. Please note that the individual health insurance will be still required, as the national health insurance will not be valid until the Foreign Registration Card(FRC) is issued, and it may not cover some unexpected matters related to international students, such as hospitalization and etc.</p>
