ELIGIBILITY

- official nomination by home university through CUT's online form
- student status at home university throughout the duration of the program
- completion of at least one year of undergraduate studies at home university by the time of nomination.
- B2 English level certified by one of the following exams: https://bit.ly/3ISMcS8

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- signed application form
- copy of passport
- transcript of records (in English)
- official English language certificate
- passport-type color photo

Exchange Program

- Exchange students are required to take between 20 and 30 credits (ECTS).
- The choice of courses (Study Plan) made during the application process is binding, therefore students are asked to make thoughtful decisions. Modifications to the Study Plan might be possible upon student arrival at CUT, but all changes are subject to course availability, capacity limitations and/or prerequisites.
- Please be advised that CUT cannot guarantee courses in advance for exchange students.

Academic Calendar

The academic year in Poland is divided into two semesters.

FALL SEMESTER

From 1st of October until mid-February. The examination session usually lasts for two or three weeks.

SPRING SEMESTER

From the last Monday of February until 30th of June.
The examination session lasts around two-three weeks.

Summer holidays last three months
– from the beginning of July
to the end of September.









Student Housing

CUT Student Housing Complex:

International students can apply for a place in twin rooms.

A place costs PLN 620*

Students can apply for a place in CUT dormitory at the time of online registration for the exchange program.

Places in the dormitory are allocated on a first-register basis.

Cost of Living
